Cue – Day Dawn Cemetery Local Law 2001

The purpose of this local law is to provide for the regulation management and control of cemetery activities within the district.

Activities in Thoroughfares and Public Places and Trading Local Law 2001

The purpose of this local law is to provide rules and outcomes with regard to advertising, signs, firebreaks, activities in thoroughfares, vehicles, laneways, roadside conservation and trading in public places.

Dogs Local Law 2001

The purpose of this local law is to provide requirements and limitations to owning a dog including impounding, fencing requirements, and dogs in public places.

Standing Orders Local Law 2015

The purpose of this local law is to provide rules, procedures and guidelines to assist in the good conduct of meetings of the Council, committees and the standards to be observed by persons attending such meetings.
